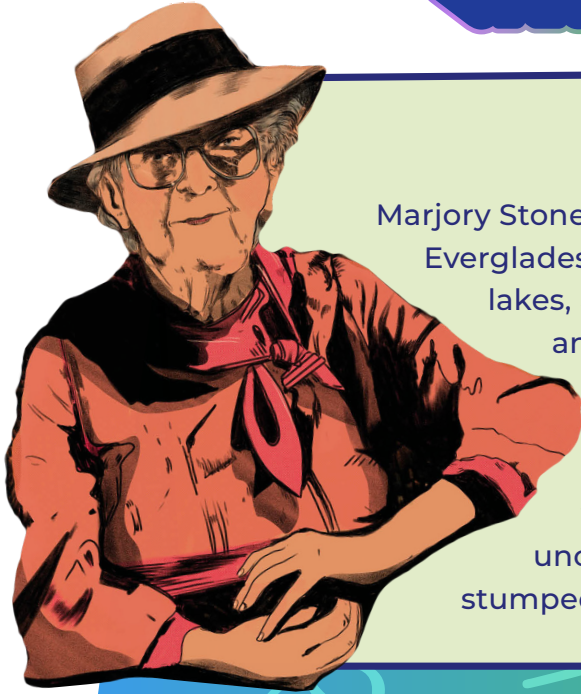

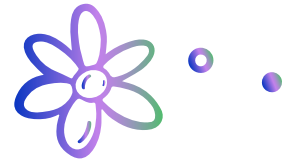

### Wangari's Word Search

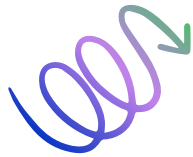


**Wangari** Maathai knows that when women work together, they can **change** the world! In 1977, she started the **Green Belt Movement**, which encourages **women** to grow **seedlings** and **plant** trees to protect the **environment**. The trees prevent soil **erosion**, produce food for communities, and provide firewood for **fuel and building**. She has done many impressive things in her life. She was the first woman from her region (east and central Africa) to earn her PhD and the first woman from **Africa** to win the Nobel **Peace** Prize. Her incredible organization has planted more than 51 million **trees** in **Kenya**.

All of the **bold words** above can be found in the puzzle below. They can go up, down, forward, backward, and even diagonally.

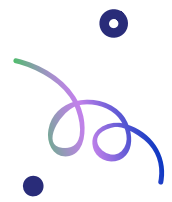
